DISPOSITION: PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE REVISED

On November 14, 2012, the Oregon Cable Telecommunications Association (OCTA) filed motions to compel the Oregon Telecommunications Association (OTA); Frontier Communications Northwest, Inc.; and CenturyLink, Inc. to produce information on an expedited basis. In conjunction with each motion, OCTA also asked for an extension of time for the submission of the parties' opening testimony.

On November 16, 2012, OCTA filed a letter indicating that it had discussed the pending motions with OTA, CenturyLink, Frontier, the Citizens Utility Board of Oregon, and the Commission Staff and that all indicated that they did not oppose changes to the schedule to provide the Commission with the opportunity to address the pending motions and to permit the parties to continue preparing their testimony.
