## Commissioner Baum:

CenturyTel has never been a company that maintained a wholesale channel and so has no experience working with CLECs. With the merger of CenturyTel and Embarg a wholesale/CLEC channel appeared in the CenturyLink company.

My business partner Kelly Mutch let me know that CenturyTel plans to cut 75% of the wholesale staff at Qwest after the merger of CenturyTel and

If this is really happens then it seems that competition from CLECs in areas currently served by Qwest is going to be substantially reduced if Centurytel takes over and cuts CLEC support staff.
