RULING

**DISPOSITION: SCHEDULE SUSPENDED; STIPULATION  
OR STATUS REPORT TO BE FILED**

On March 15, 2011, Portland General Electric Company (PGE) filed a motion to suspend the procedural schedule in this docket. PGE explains that PGE, the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon, and the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon have reached a comprehensive settlement in principle on all issues in this docket. According to PGE, there is a possibility that the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (ICNU) may oppose part of the settlement. PGE states, however, that no party opposes its motion to suspend the procedural schedule. Because PGE's testimony is due today, PGE asks for expedited consideration of its motion.

PGE's motion is granted. The existing procedural schedule is suspended. PGE should file a status report by March 29, 2011, if a stipulation has not been filed by that date.
