DISPOSITION: MOTION TO AMEND SCHEDULE GRANTED

On January 25, 2013, the Community Renewable Energy Association (CREA) filed a motion to amend the procedural schedule in this docket. CREA asks that Issue 6(e) addressing mechanical availability be considered in Phase I. CREA states no parties object to the request, although some have expressed concerns about timing. Phase I opening testimony from utilities is currently due on February 4, 2013. To address these concerns, CREA recommends that utilities be given until February 19 to file testimony on mechanical availability.

CREA's motion is adopted. Issue 6(e) will be addressed in Phase I. The procedural schedule is modified to allow the utilities until February 19, 2013, to file testimony on mechanical availability.
