RULING

DISPOSITION: COMPLIANCE FILING DEADLINE EXTENDED

On June 23, 2015, the Commission issued Order No. 15-200, adopting a Staff recommendation requiring Idaho Power to “file its request for-cost effective exceptions for specific DSM measures on an annual basis or, in years where Idaho Power has no need for such a request, the Company file its annual DSM report electronically in the UM 1710 docket.” Since this order was issued, Idaho Power has complied with this directive.

Idaho Power’s last annual compliance filing made consistent with this order was filed April 2, 2019. Through this ruling, I clarify for Idaho Power, that given the business practice and operational constraints placed on Idaho Power, the Commission, and other stakeholders and utilities given the COVID-19 response, Idaho Power may delay the filing of this report 60 days, at its discretion.

Accordingly, the date by which Idaho Power’s compliance filing for docket UM 1710 must be filed is now June 1, 2020.
