DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED, PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE SUSPENDED

On July 14, 2017, PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power, filed an unopposed motion to suspend the procedural schedule to allow the parties additional time to finalize a settlement stipulation and prepare supporting testimony. It requests expedited consideration because the current procedural schedule's due date for the company's rebuttal testimony and all parties' cross testimony is today, July 14, 2017.

In support of its motion, PacifiCorp states the parties have worked diligently to finalize an agreement in principle and draft a settlement stipulation. PacifiCorp asserts that the public interest is served by allowing the parties to focus on finalizing the settlement rather than litigation. PacifiCorp states that no party has objected to suspending the schedule.

For good cause shown, PacifiCorp's motion is granted. The procedural schedule is suspended.

PacifiCorp is directed to file a status report with the Commission by July 28, 2017 and the final stipulation and supporting testimony by August 11, 2017.
