DISPOSITION: MOTIONS GRANTED

On October 4, 2017, eMeter, a Siemens Company (Siemens) filed a motion requesting that its witness, Chris King, be permitted to participate by telephone in the hearing scheduled for October 10, 2017, in Salem, Oregon. Siemens explains that Mr. King has a business conflict that afternoon in Washington, D.C.

ChargePoint, Inc. has requested 30 minutes of time to cross-examine Mr. King on the issues of utility ownership of electric vehicle service equipment; and the size, structure, and scope of the proposed Electric Avenue program.

On October 4, 2017, Electric Vehicle Charging Association (EVCA) filed a motion to allow its witness, Dr. Abdellah Cherkaoui, to also participate by telephone. EVCA explains that Dr. Cherkaoui is located out of state. No party requested to cross-examine Dr. Cherkaoui, but the Commission requests he be available for potential Commissioner examination.

For good cause shown, the motions are granted conditioned upon the failure to receive any objections before the close of business on October 5, 2017.
