ORDER

DISPOSITION: MOTION TO SUSPEND SCHEDULE GRANTED IN PART

On March 16, 2018, the Northwest and Intermountain Power Producers Coalition (NIPPC) and the Renewable Energy Coalition (the Coalition) filed a motion to suspend the procedural schedule indefinitely to allow further settlement discussions. Portland General Electric Company and the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities oppose an indefinite delay, but offer a three-week extension of the existing schedule to provide parties additional time to consider settlement.

NIPPC's and the Coalition's motion is granted in part. The existing procedural schedule is delayed by three-weeks. The schedule is modified as follows:
