RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION TO MODIFY SCHEDULE GRANTED

On June 13, 2018, Portland General Electric Company filed a motion to extend all deadlines in the existing schedule by eight weeks to help facilitate the parties' efforts to finalize settlement. PGE states that the parties hope to file a stipulation with the Commission on or before June 29, 2018. PGE adds that Northwest and Intermountain Power Producers Coalition, Community Renewable Energy Association, Renewable Energy Coalition, and Renewables Northwest support an indefinite stay of the schedule rather than the proposed eight-week extension.

PGE's motion is granted. The existing procedural schedule is delayed by eight-weeks. The schedule is modified as follows:
