RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME GRANTED

On August 25, 2017, Covanta Marion, Inc. (Covanta) filed a motion requesting an extension of time in which to answer the complaint and request for dispute resolution filed by Portland General Electric Company (PGE). Because the answer to the complaint is due August 31, 2017, Covanta asks for expedited consideration of its motion.


In support of its request, Covanta states that it has recently retained new counsel and that the additional time is necessary due to scheduling conflicts. Covanta states that it has conferred with counsel for PGE and that the company does not object to its request.

RULING

I find that Covanta Marion, Inc. has shown good cause for granting the motion and that granting the motion will not unduly delay the proceedings or burden the record. The motion is granted.

Covanta Marion, Inc. shall file its answer to the complaint and request for dispute resolution filed by Portland General Electric Company no later than September 8, 2017.
