DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED; COMMISSION WORKSHOP SET
FOR OCTOBER 22, 2018

By motion filed October 9, 2018, Hydro One and Avista request that the Commission convene a workshop on October 22, 2018, “structured around any impact of management changes at Hydro One on the Proposed Transaction or Avista, and the role of the Province of Ontario, if any, in the future affairs of Hydro One and Avista.” Hydro One and Avista propose to make their respective senior executives available to participate in the workshop. The timing of their request is based on a similar proceeding to be held at the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission on October 23, 2018, where those same executives will be present.

According to Avista, no party opposes its motion.

For good cause shown, I grant the motion. The workshop is set for October 22, 2018, beginning at 1:30 p.m.
