Application for Authorization to Exercise Substantial Influence over the Policies and Actions of AVISTA CORPORATION.

DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED

On June 12, 2018, Hydro One Limited and Avista Corporation filed a motion on behalf of all the parties for an extension of time to file testimony in support of the stipulation filed on May 25, 2018. The original deadline for the testimony was June 13, 2018; and the parties request an extension to June 19, 2018, stating additional time is needed to assure that the supporting testimony is comprehensive in nature. Hydro One and Avista state that they conferred with all parties, and all parties support this request. Hydro One and Avista also note that since the June 21, 2018, date for oral argument was vacated by Notice issued on June 8, 2018, the parties do not believe that an extension of the filing date for supporting testimony will prejudice the remaining schedule.
