DISPOSITION: PETITION TO INTERVENE GRANTED FOR LIMITED
PURPOSES

The Commission has received a petition to intervene in this docket from the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities, currently known as Alliance of Western Energy Consumers (AWEC).

This proceeding is not a contested case proceeding under ORS 183.310(2). Nonetheless, obtaining party status is necessary for purposes of receiving copies of filings made by others and to be eligible to sign a protective order to obtain access to confidential information. For those reasons, the Commission will grant the petitions to intervene, even though party status does not confer the general rights and duties to individuals who participate in contested case proceedings.

The petition to intervene filed by AWEC is granted for the limited purposes described above.
