DISPOSITION: EXHIBITS OFFERED AT HEARING ADMITTED INTO THE RECORD

A hearing was held in this docket on October 8, 2020. At the hearing, the Northwest and Intermountain Power Producers Coalition (NIPPC) offered Exhibits 400, 401, 402, 403, and 405 through 418 and moved that they be entered into the record. Calpine Energy Solutions (Calpine) offered Exhibits 200, 201, 202 and 203 and moved that they be entered into the record.¹

At my direction, on October 9, 2020, Calpine filed a Motion to Admit Supplemental Hearing Exhibit. A copy of Calpine Solutions Exhibit 202 Supplemental was attached to the motion. Calpine states that this exhibit may replace the originally admitted Calpine Solutions Exhibit 202, which was PGE's original response to NIPPC's Data Request No. 007. By ruling of October 9, 2020, Calpine Exhibit 202 Supplemental was admitted into the record.

By agreement of the parties, each of the foregoing exhibits was admitted into the record with the exceptions of NIPPC Exhibit 405 and Calpine Exhibit 203, both of which consisted of the response of Portland General Electric Company (PGE) to NIPPC Data Request 002. PGE reserved its right to object to the admission of NIPPC Exhibit 405 and Calpine Exhibit 203, but did not ultimately object to the admission of these exhibits during the course of the hearing.²
