RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION TO AMEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE GRANTED

On June 25, 2020, Chief Administrative Law Judge Nolan Moser granted a motion by the parties to suspend the schedule and directed the parties to file either a proposed schedule or status report on or before July 2, 2020.

On July 2, 2020, Portland General Electric Company filed a motion on behalf of the parties to amend the procedural schedule and requested expedited consideration. In support of the motion, PGE represents that the Commission Staff supports PGE's motion and that the parties Avangrid Renewables; Alliance of Western Energy Consumers; Oregon Citizens' Utility Board; PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power; Renewable Northwest; Walmart, Inc.; Calpine Energy Solutions; Northwest and Intermountain Power Producers Coalition; and NW Energy Coalition do not oppose PGE's motion. PGE's proposed procedural schedule is as follows:
