DISPOSITION: UNOPPOSED MOTION TO STAY GRANTED

On March 21, 2022, PGE filed an unopposed motion to stay the case proceedings and requested expedited consideration. In the motion, PGE asked that the deadline for PGE to respond to Waconda Solar LLC's ("Waconda Solar") Motion for Partial Summary Judgment ("MPSJ") be extended to April 27, 2022. In addition, PGE noted that if the case remains unsettled by April 20, 2022, the parties would return to litigation. PGE's response to Waconda's MPSJ would be due one week later.

The parties state that the extension of time is necessary to focus on a potential settlement of this case

## **RULING**

I find that granting the Unopposed Motion to Stay the Proceedings will not unduly delay the proceedings or burden the record. The motion is granted. Portland General Electric Company and Waconda Solar, LLC, shall file a status update on or before April 20, 2022.
