DISPOSITION: REVISED SCHEDULE ADOPTED

On January 22, 2020, Portland General Electric Company made a motion to amend the procedural schedule in this case, holding in abeyance the deadline for the filing of reply testimony, currently set for February 4, 2020. Madras PVI, LLC (Madras Solar) objected to the motion.

In order to move this proceeding towards a final scope and record to present to the Commission for consideration, I grant in part and deny in part PGE's request. PGE shall consolidate its reply to Madras Solar's response to PGE's motion to amend its answer and counterclaim with its response to Madras Solar's motion for clarification.
