CLARIFICATION OF PRIOR RULING

Investigation Into the Use of Northwest Natural's Renewable Natural Gas Evaluation Methodology.

On October 7, 2019, I granted the petition to intervene filed on September 26, 2019 by the Alliance of Western Energy Consumers (AWEC). The ruling was accompanied by an attached Notice of Contested Case Rights and Procedures. This proceeding is not a contested case under ORS 183.310(2).

Persons may seek party status; however, for the limited purpose of obtaining access to confidential information pursuant to the terms of a protective order. Party status in this proceeding does not confer the general rights and duties as those of parties in contested case proceedings.
