Investigation into Treatment of Network Upgrade Costs for Qualifying Facilities.

DISPOSITION: EXPEDITED SCHEDULE ADOPTED; JOINT UTILITIES' TO MAKE SHOW CAUSE FILING

On September 2, 2020, a motion to strike was filed by the Northwest and Intermountain Power Producers Coalition, Renewable Energy Coalition, and the Community Renewable Energy Association (together the Interconnection Customer Coalition). The motion seeks to strike portions of the Joint Utilities' Exhibit 100 and Exhibit 200 alleged to improperly offer legal argument by non-lawyer witnesses.

The motion first requests expedited consideration in order to provide resolution that allows sufficient time to prepare response testimony. The motion suggests an expedited schedule for its consideration, as follows:

This expedited schedule would facilitate a ruling to be issued during the week of September 21, 2020, the motion indicates, with Response Testimony due on October 19, 2020. The Interconnection Customer Coalition conferred with PacifiCorp dba Pacific Power, Portland General Electric Company, and Idaho Power Company (collectively the Joint Utilities) regarding the proposed expedited schedule but they oppose its implementation, the motion states.

The Interconnection Customer Coalition's proposal for an expedited schedule puts a greater burden on the Interconnection Customer Coalition than on the Joint Utilities. In the interest of maintaining the existing procedural schedule, I find it appropriate to expedite consideration of the motion to strike. Based on the Interconnection Customer Coalition's representation that the Joint Utilities' oppose expedited consideration, however, I will allow the Joint Utilities to show good cause to deny expedited

consideration of the motion to the strike by making a filing on the limited issue of expedited consideration by the close of business tomorrow, September 4, 2020.
