DISPOSITION: UPDATES REQUESTED, RESPONSES PERMITTED

During the September 22, 2020 Special Public Meeting, the Commission discussed three main topics: sensitivity design, initial bid scoring, and interconnection queue issues. This memorandum sets out filing dates for the Commission to receive and review updated information.

Independent Evaluator (IE) to file an updated status report describing: (1) initial bid scoring and ranking with explanations of the costs and benefits seen in different locations and with different resources, and (2) the impact of the signed Large Generator Interconnection Agreements (LGIAs) on the competition at each transmission topology location	November 20, 2020
PacifiCorp, Staff, parties, or any bidders may file comments on the IE's Update	December 4, 2020
Staff or the IE to file a description of sensitivity design	December 8, 2020
PacifiCorp to file indicative sensitivity analysis	December 11, 2020
Special Public Meeting for discussion	December 17, 2020, 9:30 a.m.

Bidders or stakeholders may have other concerns with the Request for Proposal (RFP) beyond the three issues identified above (sensitivity design, initial bid scoring, and interconnection queue issues). These other concerns or comments may be included in December comments. The Commission will review issues raised and strive to include them in the agenda that will be posted before the December 17, 2020 Special Public Meeting.
