RULING

**DISPOSITION: EIGHTH JOINT MOTION TO MODIFY PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE  
GRANTED**

On July 13, 2020, Complainant Zena Solar, LLC and Defendant PGE (collectively, the joint parties) filed a joint motion requesting expedited consideration and approval of an eighth procedural schedule modification in these proceedings. In the motion, the joint parties state that the purpose of the requested deadline modifications are to provide the joint parties additional time to explore a possible settlement. The requested changes are as follows:

Zena Solar Response to Counterclaims	July 13, 2020	July 27, 2020
Selection of Procedural Path	July 13, 2020	July 27, 2020
PGE Response to Zena Solar Motion for Interim Relief and Preliminary Injunction	July 24, 2020 (dependent on procedural path selected on June 15, 2020)	August 7, 2020 (dependent on procedural path selected on July 27, 2020)
Interim Relief Period Deadline	August 25, 2020	September 8, 2020

Subsequently or in substitution of some of the dates listed above, the joint parties further state that they will follow one of two procedural paths. In the first path, the joint parties will resolve Zena's motion for interim relief and preliminary injunction first, and then commence a second part resolving the merits of the case.

Under the second path, the joint parties will endeavor to resolve both issues simultaneously.

**RULING**

I grant the motion. Having shown good cause, the joint parties shall abide by the agreed upon procedural schedule as presented above. I request that the joint parties file any further proposed procedural revisions in a joint motion on or before July 27, 2020, to clarify the procedural path that the parties choose.
