## DISPOSITION: MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME GRANTED

On April 7, 2020, Complainant Zena Solar, LLC and Defendant PGE (collectively, the joint parties) filed a joint motion for an extension of time to collaborate on the development of a procedural schedule in this proceeding. The joint parties, if successful in developing a schedule, plan to file a proposal by Friday, April 10, 2020.

In support of the motion, the joint parties state that they have agreed to an extension of the temporary interim relief period from April 17, 2020 to April 30, 2020. The period of time for PGE to file a response to Complainant's motion for interim relief and preliminary injunction would be extended from April 13, 2020 to April 24, 2020. Finally, the deadline for PGE to file an answer to the complaint would be extended from April 16, 2020 to April 29, 2020.

## RULING

The motion is granted. Having shown good cause, the joint parties shall abide by the agreed upon extensions as presented above, and file a joint, proposed procedural schedule by April 10, 2020.
