RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION TO ADMIT COUNSEL *PRO HAC VICE* GRANTED

On July 14, 2021, Walmart Inc. filed a motion to allow Vicki M. Baldwin to appear as counsel *pro hac vice* in this proceeding. The certificate of compliance of Ms. Baldwin accompanied the motion. Ms. Baldwin states that she will associate with Brandon J. Mark, an active member in good standing with the Oregon State Bar.

I have reviewed the motion for admission *pro hac vice* and find that it complies with the requirements of UTCR 3.170 and OAR 860-001-0320. No objections have been received.

The motion to admit Vicki M. Baldwin as counsel *pro hac vice* on behalf of Walmart Inc. is granted for a one-year period. For cases continuing over one year, an attorney appearing *pro hac vice* must file a new application to continue to participate in the case.¹
