DISPOSITION: RESPONSE TIMES SHORTENED

On March 8, 2024, the Portland General Electric Company (PGE) filed a motion for a Modified Protective Order in this proceeding. PGE states that it anticipates receiving bids in response to its RFP that—along with PGE's evaluation of the bids—will contain highly confidential, commercially sensitive information of both bidders and PGE. PGE conferred with parties prior to filing its motion and has been informed that at least one entity intends to oppose to modified protective order.

Because the next step in this proceeding is scheduled for March 26, 2024, PGE requests that the deadline for responses be shortened such that responses are due on March 18, 2024; PGE's reply timeline would also be shortened such that PGE's reply would be due on March 22, 2024, in order to accommodate a Modified Protective Order being issued by March 26, 2024.

I find good cause to grant PGE's motion. Responses to PGE's motion are due on March 18, 2024, and replies are due on March 22, 2024.
