DISPOSITION: SCHEDULE FOR COMMENTS ADOPTED

At the March 16, 2004 Public Meeting, the Commission Staff (Staff) presented a report on the status of the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) comprehensive settlement and review of conditional deferral of Reduction of Risk Discount under PacifiCorp's financial settlement agreement. Staff recommended the Commission revisit this issue at its May 4, 2004, Public Meeting and, at that time, direct PacifiCorp to terminate the deferral of its Reduction of Risk Discount payments under PacifiCorp's Financial Settlement Agreement with BPA.

The Public Power Council, Oregon Electric Cooperative Association, Oregon Electric Utilities, Oregon People's Utility District Association, Snohomish Public Utility District, and the Oregon Rural Electric Cooperative Association appeared at the March 16, 2004 Public Meeting and submitted comments in response to Staff's proposal. All noted the importance of this matter and requested that the Commission hold a separate public meeting to solicit further comments from interested persons.

The Commission adopted Staff's recommendation to revisit this issue at a public meeting to be held on or about May 4, 2004. The Commission also asked interested persons to submit written comments on Staff's proposal prior to that meeting. The Commissioners specifically requested that any alternative recommendation include a discussion of the Commission's ability to adopt such alternative given its statutory responsibilities to customers of investor owned utilities.
