**DISPOSITION: BRIEFING SCHEDULE EXTENDED ONE WEEK**

On May 19, 2006, the parties filed opening briefs addressing Qwest’s proposal to rebalance rates in this docket. On June 7, 2006, I issued a Memorandum raising an additional issue not addressed in the opening briefs. Attached to the Memorandum was a proposed decision. I requested the parties address the proposed decision in their reply briefs due June 16, 2006.

On June 13, 2006, Qwest Corporation filed a request to extend the date to file reply briefs until June 30, 2006. Qwest represents that Staff does not oppose the extension. The other party participating in this phase of the proceeding, the Northwest Public Communications Council, did not file an opening brief.

Because of scheduling constraints and other pending matters, it is only possible to grant a one week extension of the briefing deadline. Reply briefs shall be filed no later than 5 p.m. on June 23, 2006.
