Application for Increase in Revenues.

On February 7, 2024, Administrative Law Judge Chris Allwein issued a ruling in this docket that suspended the procedural schedule through March 5, 2024, and granted in part Northwest Public Communications Corp.'s (NPCC) motion for reconsideration. The ruling ordered "Qwest * * * to file tariffs for Qwest rates for PAL and CustomNet/Fraud Protection in place from May 1, 1996, through 2003."¹ The ruling did not contain a deadline by which Qwest was to file such tariffs and Qwest has not yet filed them.

Qwest shall file the materials it was ordered to file in the February 7 ruling by 3:00 p.m. on March 13, 2024. In the alternative, Qwest may file a letter explaining why it has not yet complied with the February 7, 2024, ruling and a specific request for additional time to comply with it by the same deadline.

The procedural schedule in this docket is suspended through April 1, 2024.
