DISPOSITION: MOTION TO COMPEL GRANTED

On September 26, 2007, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon Staff (Staff) filed a motion to compel Crooked River Ranch Water Company (Crooked River) to respond to its Data Request No. 128. Crooked River did not file any response to Staff's motion.

In its motion, Staff describes the materials that are the subject of the motion and explains their relevance. The information is plainly relevant, and Staff's motion is granted.

I note that Staff also states its intention to request a subpoena for information not provided pursuant to its three motions to compel. OAR 860-014-0040(1) provides that a subpoena may be issued by an attorney of record. Only parties not represented by attorneys must apply for a subpoena (pursuant to OAR 860-014-0040(3)).

Staff's Motion to Compel is granted, and Crooked River Ranch Water Company shall provide full and complete answers to Data Request No. 128 within five days of service of this ruling.
