SUNRIVER WATER LLC, Request for a General Rate Revision. MEMORANDUM: NOTICE OFSTAFF RECOMMENDATION ON SERVICE TERRITORY EXPANSION APPLICATION AT THE OCTOBER 21, 2021 REGULAR PUBLIC MEETING

On April 7, 2021, Sunriver Water, LLC (Sunriver), submitted an application for expansion of its service territory. Sunriver currently serves 4497 residential and 237 commercial customers. If the application is approved, Sunriver will provide domestic water service to the proposed Caldera Springs Annexation, which is adjacent to Sunriver's current service territory. This expansion will add up to 415 residential customers and 3 additional commercial customers. Sunriver plans to serve the expanded service area with unused capacity in its existing system and enhancements to its system over a 5 to 10-year period.

At the Commission's October 21, 2021 Regular Public Meeting, Staff of the Oregon Public Utility Commission will provide a recommendation on Sunriver's service territory expansion application. The Staff report will be posted to the regular public meeting agenda prior to the meeting date. A link to the regular public meeting agenda may be found <u>HERE</u>. The agenda includes a link to access the meeting and provides instruction on how to make public comments.

At the regular public meeting, when the Commission reaches public meeting agenda item RAI, Staff will provide a brief presentation on its recommendation. Following the Staff presentation, the Commission may have questions or requests for clarification. Next, the Commission will take public comment. Comments should be limited to Sunriver's application for expansion of its service territory. Finally, the Commission will deliberate on whether to accept Staff's recommendation.
