DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED; SCHEDULE SUSPENDED

On May 28, 2021 Sunriver Water LLC, filed a request for a general rate revision. Under Order No. 21-177 issued on June 2, 2021, the tariff sheets were suspended. A public comment hearing and prehearing conference were held on July 8, 2021. At the prehearing conference, a procedural schedule for the remainder of the case was adopted.

On January 5, 2022, Sunriver Water LLC, Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon ("Staff") and Sunriver Owners Association ("SROA") (collectively, the "Parties") filed a motion asking that the procedural schedule in this docket be suspended, requesting expedited consideration. In support of its motion, Staff represents all parties to this proceeding have reached a settlement in principle that resolves all issues, and that no party has interposed any objection to its motion. The Parties further state that they intend to file a stipulation, supporting testimony, and a motion to admit and adopt the stipulation on or before January 31, 2022.

I find that the Parties have shown good cause for suspending the procedural schedule.

RULING

- 1. The procedural schedule in this docket is suspended.
- 2. The Parties shall file the stipulation, supporting testimony and affidavits or declarations, and a motion to admit and adopt the stipulation, or in the alternative, a joint status report, on or before January 31, 2022.
