DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED

On September 25, 2023, Staff of the Oregon Public Utility Commission moved to amend the procedural schedule in this docket. Staff states that the motion is unopposed by all parties to the docket. In short, Staff and the Seavey Loop Water Company, LLC, have reached a settlement on all issues except one. Two intervenors oppose the settlement. Accordingly, Staff proposes a procedural schedule to (1) allow for filing of the stipulation and opposition to the stipulation, and (2) resolve the remaining fully contested issue in this case on affiliate labor. Staff requests expedited consideration.
