RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED

On October 16, 2023, Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon filed a motion to suspend the procedural schedule. Staff states that the parties in these proceedings have reached a settlement in principle that resolves all issues, including the previously contested cost of affiliate labor, and the parties need adequate time to record their agreement and update their written stipulation and supporting testimony. Staff requests expedited consideration of the motion because of the deadline to file the stipulating parties' stipulation and testimony is today. Staff states that the parties intend to file the stipulation and supporting testimony by November 10, 2023, or alternatively a status update if the parties are unable to make the filing. Staff represents that it reached out to intervenors Carrie Rose, Dianne Chin, and Yeager St. John about the need for additional time to record the agreement and Carrie Rose does not object; Staff has not received responses from Dianne Chinn and Yeager St. John.

For good cause shown, I grant Staff's motion on an expedited basis. The procedural schedule is suspended. Staff is directed to file a stipulation and supporting testimony or a status report by 3:00 p.m. on November 10, 2023.
