## DISPOSITION: MODIFIED SCHEDULE ADOPTED

On June 9, 2005, a telephone prehearing conference was held in this docket. Qwest Corporation (Qwest); Integra Telecom of Oregon, Inc.; the Telecommunications Ratepayers Association for Cost-Based and Equitable Rates; Covad Communications Company; Time-Warner Telecom; and the Commission staff (Staff) entered appearances in the case.

Staff summarized the status of the Final Competitive Local Exchange Carrier (CLEC) Survey Report (Report), and Staff estimated that an additional two weeks would be needed to obtain data clarification, plus an additional two weeks to prepare the Report. Staff also clarified that the Report is only a compilation of data and will have no analysis or narrative.

Qwest indicated that a possible work stoppage due to collective bargaining issues may interfere with the proposed UX 29 schedule when their labor contracts expire August 15, 2005.

The parties agreed to, and the Administrative Law Judge adopted, the following schedule subject to modification in the event of a Qwest labor dispute:
