DISPOSITION: MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME GRANTED

By motion filed February 4, 2011, Crooked River Ranch Water Company (Crooked River) requests an extension of time to file a joint proposal for how the Commission should respond to pending matters in the Court of Appeals.¹ The date previously set for filing the joint proposal was February 4, 2011. Crooked River states that Staff joins in the motion.

As grounds for its motion, Crooked River states that conflicting schedules have prevented the parties from finalizing the joint proposal. Crooked River proposes that the time be extended to February 11, 2011.

For good cause shown, the motion is granted. The time for filing the joint proposal is extended to February 11, 2011.
