**JOINT
PREHEARING CONFERENCE
MEMORANDUM**

DISPOSITION: PROCEDURAL SCHEDULES ADOPTED

The Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) held a joint prehearing conference in the above-referenced dockets on February 15, 2011. Representatives from PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power (Pacific Power); Portland General Electric Company (PGE); Commission Staff; the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon (CUB); and the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (ICNU) appeared at the conference.

Stipulations have been filed in both of these dockets. On February 7, 2011, ICNU filed objections to both stipulations, along testimony in support of its objections. PGE and Pacific Power each filed motions to strike ICNU's objections and supporting testimony in the respective dockets. The motions to strike are taken under advisement and will be ruled upon at a later date.

During the conference, the following procedural schedule was adopted in both dockets:


