**DISPOSITION: DATES SET FOR WORKSHOP, PREHEARING
CONFERENCE**

A prehearing conference was held in this matter on April 11, 2007. Appearing were Portland General Electric Company, Community Action Directors of Oregon/Oregon Energy Coordinators Association (CADO/OECA), and Commission Staff. The Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon appeared via telephone. At the conference the parties informed the Commission that a workshop is scheduled for April 24, 2007, at the headquarters of Portland General Electric Company, 121 W. Salmon St., Portland, Oregon 97204. At the workshop parties may discuss substantive and procedural matters, including a proposed schedule.

Petitions to intervene have been filed by the Oregon Department of Energy (ODOE), the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (ICNU) and the Community Action Directors of Oregon (CADO)/Oregon Energy Coordinators Association (OECA).

The time to file any opposition having passed, ODOE's petition is granted. ICNU and CADO/OECA's petitions are granted conditionally, subject to the filing of a timely protest.

The deadline for filing petitions to intervene is May 10, 2007.

At the request of PGE, a second prehearing conference is scheduled for Thursday, May, 10, 2007. The Commission will issue a formal notice with the specifics prior to the conference.

Staff is directed to notice all parties and interested persons of the time and location of the workshop.
