DISPOSITION: PETITION TO INTERVENE GRANTED; SCHEDULE ESTABLISHED

On April 17, 2007, a prehearing conference was held in Salem, Oregon. Portland General Electric Company, Commission Staff, PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power & Light Company, and Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (ICNU) appeared in person; the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon (CUB) appeared by phone.

On April 6, 2007, CUB had submitted its notice of intervention, pursuant to ORS 774.180. On April 17, 2007, ICNU submitted a petition to intervene. At the prehearing conference, no party objected to ICNU's petition. Pursuant to OAR 860-012-0001, I find that ICNU has sufficient interest in the proceeding, and ICNU's appearance and participation will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or unreasonably delay the proceeding. The petition is granted.
