**PREHEARING CONFERENCE
MEMORANDUM**

DISPOSITION: SCHEDULE ADOPTED

A prehearing conference was held in this matter on March 16, 2010. Appearing at the conference were Katherine McDowell, on behalf of PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power (Pacific Power); Irion Sanger, on behalf of the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (ICNU); Jason Jones on behalf of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon Staff (Staff); and G. Catriona McCracken on behalf of Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon (CUB). Greg Adams appeared by telephone on behalf of Semptra Energy Solutions, LLC (Semptra). Daniel Eisenbeis appeared by telephone on behalf of the League of Oregon Cities.

On March 4, 2010, ICNU filed its petition to intervene. On March 9, 2010, Semptra filed its petition to intervene and a motion to admit counsel *pro hac vice*, asking that Greg Adams, a member in good standing of the Idaho State Bar, be recognized in this proceeding. CUB filed its notice of intervention on March 3, 2010, and is a party to this proceeding.


