PREHEARING CONFERENCE
MEMORANDUM

On May 6, 2013, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon held a prehearing conference in this docket. Representatives appeared in person or by telephone on behalf of Commission Staff; PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power; Shell Energy North America (US), L.P. (Shell Energy); Fred Meyer Stores, a subsidiary of the Kroger Co. and Quality Food Centers (Kroger); the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (ICNU); Noble Americas Energy Solutions LLC (Noble); the Northwest & Intermountain Power Producers Coalition (NIPPC); Constellation NewEnergy, Inc.; and Vitesse LLC (Vitesse).

Procedural Schedule

Conference participants agreed to the following procedural schedule, which was adopted:

Staff and Intervenors file simultaneous Reply Testimony	September 13, 2013
<i>Settlement Conference</i>	<i>September 26, 2013</i>
Pacific Power files Rebuttal Testimony	October 18, 2013
Hearing	November 18, 2013

The settlement conference is documented in the official schedule for the parties' convenience only. Parties do not need notice or Commission approval to reschedule the conference.

The schedule includes a requested date for petitions to intervene. By statute, a person may petition to intervene at any time before the close of the record.¹ It is helpful if


parties are identified early in the proceedings, therefore, petitions to intervene are requested to be filed by the date identified above.

Parties are reminded that attorneys not licensed in Oregon wanting to appear before the Commission in this docket must file an application for admission to appear *pro hac vice*.²

After September 8, 2013, conference participants agreed to shorten the discovery turnaround time to eight business days.

Conference participants agreed that Staff or intervenors may file motions to schedule a date to file rebuttal testimony after Pacific Power files its rebuttal testimony.
