DISPOSITION: SCHEDULE ADOPTED

On April 14, 2005, a consolidated prehearing conference was held in Salem, Oregon. The purpose of the conference was to identify issues and set a schedule.

Avista Corporation (Avista), Cascade Natural Gas Corporation, Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon, Idaho Power Company, Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities, NW Energy Coalition, Northwest Independent Power Producers' Coalition, NW Natural, Portland General Electric Company, PacifiCorp, Renewable Northwest Project, and Staff were present.

On April 12, 2005, Avista filed a motion to intervene out of time and a petition to intervene in Docket No. UM 1182. No one objected to either filing. Avista has sufficient interest in the proceeding, and its appearance and participation will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or unreasonably delay the proceeding. *See* OAR 860-012-0001. The motion and petition are granted.

The caption for Docket No. UM 1056 is changed to more accurately reflect the current terminology used by the parties. The words *least cost* are replaced by the words *integrated resource*. The corrected heading is used in this document, and should be used for all future filings.
