Investigation Regarding Competitive Bidding.

DISPOSITION: PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE ESTABLISHED

On January 26, 2011, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) held a prehearing conference in this docket. The primary purpose of the conference was to set a procedural schedule. Representatives appeared on behalf of the following: Commission Staff; the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon; Portland General Electric Company; PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power; Idaho Power Company; the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities; the Renewable Northwest Project; the Northwest and Intermountain Power Producers Coalition; the NW Energy Coalition; and TYR Energy.

Background

In Order No. 11-001, the Commission reopened this docket to "further examine issues related to our competitive bidding guidelines."¹ The Commission identified three specific issues to be addressed: (1) whether the role of the independent evaluator should be expanded by retaining the independent evaluator through negotiations and final resource selection (Guideline 11); (2) whether the threshold for a "major resource" should be lowered to include more projects in the competitive bidding process (Guideline 1); and (3) determination of the appropriate analytic framework and methodologies to use to evaluate and compare resource ownership to purchasing power from an independent power producer (Guideline 10(d)).

The parties agreed to divide these proceedings into two phases. Phase I will address the Commission's first two issues. After an order is issued in Phase I, a prehearing conference will be held to set a schedule for Phase II, which will address the third issue. The parties also may request the opportunity to raise other issues in Phase II.
