PREHEARING CONFERENCE REPORT

DISPOSITION: PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE ESTABLISHED

On February 28, 2006, a prehearing conference was held in the above captioned proceeding. The primary purpose of the prehearing conference was to establish a full procedural schedule for the docket.

Appearances were entered as follows: David Hatton (in lieu of Stephanie Andrus) appeared on behalf of Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission); Doug Tingey appeared on behalf of Portland General Electric Company (PGE); Jason Eisdorfer appeared on behalf of the Citizens' Utility Board (CUB); and Brad Van Cleve appeared on behalf of the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (ICNU).

Parties agreed to address the following issues in the first phase of this proceeding: 1) Whether PGE's application meets deferral requirements; 2) What deferral mechanism should be used; and 3) What are the rate implications of the deferral. A second phase would address amortization and prudency issues. Following issuance of an order that authorizes a second phase, a prehearing conference will be held to establish a procedural schedule for the second phase. Parties agreed to, and I adopted, the following procedural schedule for the first phase:
