The Commission will issue an adopted issues list prior to the May 2 workshop. Another prehearing conference will be scheduled after the May 2 workshop to determine the remainder of the docket schedule.

Petitions to intervene have been filed by several parties. The petitions of the Oregon Department of Energy and the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities were filed more than ten days previously and are granted. The petitions of PacifiCorp, Portland General Electric Company, and the Northwest Industrial Gas Users are granted conditionally, subject to the right of any party to protest within the time allowed.
