On November 14, 2007, a prehearing conference was held in Salem, Oregon, in the above-captioned docket. The primary purpose of the prehearing conference was to establish a procedural schedule for the docket. The following parties appeared at the conference: David B. Hatton on behalf of Commission Staff (Staff) and Michelle Mishoe on behalf of PacifiCorp, d/b/a Pacific Power & Light Company (Pacific Power).

Staff’s Motion to Withdraw Motion to Reschedule Prehearing Conference, filed November 9, 2007, was granted.

The participants proposed, and I adopted, the procedural schedule set forth below. I have modified the schedule to include a deadline for petitions to intervene.
