DISPOSITION: SCHEDULE MODIFIED

On October 30, 2015, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon held an expedited telephone prehearing conference in this docket. Representatives appeared on behalf of Commission Staff; Idaho Power Company; PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power; Portland General Electric Company; the Oregon Department of Energy; the Renewable Energy Coalition; and Obsidian Renewables.

The purpose of the prehearing conference was to discuss Idaho Power's motion for leave to file supplemental testimony filed on October 28, 2015.

The parties agreed to the following procedural schedule, which was adopted:

Cross-Exam Statements and Exhibits due	November 16, 2015


Idaho Power's motion for leave to file supplemental testimony is granted.

There shall be a two-day data response turnaround from Idaho Power on data requests related to Idaho Power's supplemental testimony.

The scope of surrebuttal testimony will be limited to the matters contained in Idaho Power's supplemental testimony and responses to data requests.

The hearing date of November 18, 2015 and post-hearing briefs due date of December 10, 2015 are unchanged.
