**PREHEARING CONFERENCE  
MEMORANDUM**

Pursuant to ORS 756.500.

On November 19, 2019, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon held a prehearing conference in this docket. Representatives appeared on behalf of Portland General Electric Company and Madras PV1, LLC. The purpose of the conference was to discuss PGE's motion to strike testimony or in the alternative require amendment of complaint and motion to stay testimony deadline.

After discussion amongst the parties, I proposed a process for resolving the motion to stay, requested parties discuss a schedule for review of the motion to strike, and noted that I would issue a memorandum in this docket containing questions that are intended to provide parties with useful input in their effort to develop a reasonable and timely path to addressing the motion to strike and moving forward to address the core controversies of the complaint.

Accordingly, I request that Madras PV1 file a written response addressing PGE's motion to stay no later than 5:00 p.m. on November 20, 2019. I intended to issue a ruling on PGE's motion to stay on November 21, 2019. In that same ruling, I intend to provide questions to assist parties in their effort to discuss scheduling of responses and resolution of the motion to strike. I also intend to request that parties provide a response to the Commission regarding the schedule and process for addressing the motion to strike by a date yet to be determined.
