DISPOSITION: PETITIONS TO INTERVENE GRANTED; SCHEDULE ADOPTED

A prehearing conference was held by telephone in this docket on August 17, 2004. Qwest Corporation (Qwest); AT&T Communications of the Pacific Northwest, Inc., and AT&T Local Services on behalf of TCG Oregon (collectively AT&T); Integra Telecom of Oregon, Inc.
