NOTICE OF USE OF GENERAL
PROTECTIVE ORDER

PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power (PacifiCorp) hereby provides notice that it anticipates designating information to be produced or used in this docket as protected under the Commission’s General Protective Order No. 23-132 (GPO). PacifiCorp expects to receive discovery requests related to the 2022 Renewable Portfolio Standard Compliance Report, including requests for proprietary cost data and models, commercially sensitive pricing information, confidential market analyses and business projections, or confidential information regarding contracts for the purchase or sale of electric power, power services, or fuel. PacifiCorp will be exposed to competitive injury if it is forced to make unrestricted disclosure of its confidential business information. The GPO is available on the Commission’s Reports & Forms webpage.¹ Other parties to the proceeding may seek access to the protected information under the terms of the GPO using the attached signatory pages, pre-marked for use in this docket.
