NOTICE OF USE OF GENERAL PROTECTIVE ORDER

PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power (PacifiCorp) hereby provides notice that it anticipates designating information to be produced or used in this docket as protected under the Commission's General Protective Order, No. 23-132 (GPO). PacifiCorp anticipates producing rating agency reports, which are obtained directly from the rating agencies. These reports are third party data that are not publicly available information and have been designated as confidential by the rating agencies. Because the reports are third party non-public data, they fall within the protection of ORCP 36(C)(1) the exemptions under Oregon Public Records Law. ORCP 36(C)(1) provides protections against unrestricted discovery of "trade secrets or other confidential research, development, or commercial information." Oregon's Uniform Trade Secrets Act, ORS 646.461 to 464.475, defines "trade secret" as information, including cost data, that: (a) derives independent economic value, actual or potential, from not being generally known to the public or to other person who can obtain economic value from its disclosure or use; and (b) is the subject of efforts that are reasonable under the circumstances to maintain its secrecy. The Oregon Public Record Law exempts from disclosure public records that are trade secrets, which "may include but are not limited to, any formula, plan, pattern, process, tool, mechanism, compound, procedure, production data, or complication of information which in not

patented, which is known only to certain individuals within an organization and which is used in a business it conducts, having actual or potential commercial value, and which gives its user an opportunity to obtain a business advantage over competitors who do not know or use it."

The GPO is available on the Commission's Reports & Forms webpage.<sup>2</sup> Other parties to the proceeding may seek access to the protected information under the terms of the GPO using the attached signatory pages, pre-marked for use in this docket.

The individuals listed in the table below are employees of PacifiCorp and are identified for purposes of accessing information designed as protected by PacifiCorp within the docket. PacifiCorp will provide updates to this table during the course of the proceeding to ensure that it accurately identifies the employees who should have access.
