OHSU's singular purpose of improving health and well-being starts in Oregon and has global impact. We are the only academic health center in the state, but we are also nationally distinguished as a research university dedicated to advancing health sciences.

When we were given the opportunity to participate in Portland General Electric's Green Future Impact product we felt it was an ideal way to show our commitment to controlling our greenhouse gas emissions and promoting a healthy living environment for our region. We are extremely grateful that the support the Oregon PUC provided to PGE in developing this product.

Green Future Impact, along with PGE's Renewable Portfolio Standard and Hydro resources will allow OHSU's electrical supply to be carbon free. We have committed to 72,000 MWh of renewable energy, over 50% of our current annual consumption. The program is particularly appealing due to the fact that it will produce a new, local facility and the price and term are at rates that are more competitive than other local renewable products. In addition, it will benefit Oregon more broadly by contributing to cleaner energy for our future and the health of our residents and our green energy economy.

In conclusion, we would like to voice our support for the Green Future Impact program and encourage the Oregon Public Utilities Commission to approve PGE's methods for customer engagement and the ways in which it worked to secure an appropriate renewable resource that met customer needs.
